## PORTRAITS OF THE SAVIOR — WEEK 5

### “The King”

04.05.2026 — Easter Sunday

The \_\_\_\_\_ is what \_\_\_\_\_ who Jesus is!

#### 1. THE KING \_\_\_\_\_

**Acts 2:24** — God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.

**Acts 2:31–32** — <sup>31</sup> he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. <sup>32</sup> This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses.

The resurrection is not just a miracle...it is a \_\_\_\_\_...it is God saying to the world...\_\_\_\_\_ IS THE KING.

The resurrection does not just reveal the \_\_\_\_\_ of the King...it exposes the \_\_\_\_\_ of the human heart.

#### 2. THE KING \_\_\_\_\_

**Acts 3:15** — and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.

**Acts 4:10** — let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead—by him this man is standing before you well.

**Acts 5:30** — The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging him on a tree.

#### 3. THE KING \_\_\_\_\_

**Acts 10:40–41** — <sup>40</sup> but God raised him on the third day and made him to appear, <sup>41</sup> not to all the people but to us who had been chosen by God as witnesses, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

**Acts 13:30–37** — <sup>30</sup> But God raised him from the dead, <sup>31</sup> and for many days he appeared to those who had come up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people. <sup>32</sup> And we bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, <sup>33</sup> this he has

fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus, as also it is written in the second Psalm, “ ‘You are my Son, today I have begotten you.’ ” <sup>34</sup> And as for the fact that he raised him from the dead, no more to return to corruption, he has spoken in this way, “ ‘I will give you the holy and sure blessings of David.’ ” <sup>35</sup> Therefore he says also in another psalm, “ ‘You will not let your Holy One see corruption.’ ” <sup>36</sup> For David, after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was laid with his fathers and saw corruption, <sup>37</sup> but he whom God raised up did not see corruption.

**Acts 17:31** — “Because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.”

**Matthew 28:19–20** — <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.
