The Theology of Worship “Transformed By Worship”

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2 Corinthians 3:18

18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

Exodus 34:29

29 When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God.

Because of what Jesus did for us, access to God's presence is now available to every believer.

The veil Paul refers to represents...separation, distance, blindness...in other words the inability to truly see God's glory.

Paul is not teaching that transformation happens because we try harder...Paul is teaching that transformation happens because we see clearer.

1-WE WILL WORSHIP WHAT WE GIVE OUR ATTENTION TO

Transformation begins with attention.

A glance might inform you...but a gaze absolutely transforms you.

"The most important thing in your life is not what you do; it is who you become." -Dallas Willard

Psalms 27:4

4 One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in his temple.

The direction of your attention determines the direction of your transformation.

2-WORSHIP IS GOD'S TOOL FOR TRANSFORMATION

We want instant transformation...but God often works through gradual transformation.

Eugene Peterson famously called discipleship..."A long obedience in the same direction."

3-THE GOAL OF WORSHIP IS CHRISTLIKENESS

God's greatest goal for us is Christlikeness...that we would be conformed into the image of His Son Jesus.

The greatest evidence of spiritual maturity is how much you resemble Jesus.
